Luks and Lieber Honored by National Child Labor Committee

The National Child Labor Committee (NCLC) has awarded its prestigious Lewis Hine Awards to Alan Luks and Mimi Lieber. Luks is Executive Director of Big Brother Big Sister of New York City. Lieber is the Founder/Former Board Chair, and current Program Committee Chair of Literacy, Inc.

Luks and Lieber were among ten men and women, volunteers and professionals, selected from across the nation recognized for their lifelong commitment to the well-being, growth, and development of children and youth. The awards were established in honor of Lewis Wickes Hine whose photographic depiction of child labor conditions during the early 20th century helped stir public opinion in favor of enactment of laws to protect children in the workplace.

The awards were presented during a ceremony on January 29th.
